The proposed right-of-way for the access road and power line follows

existing tracks and property lines and in some cases requires

widened and upgraded portions of existing road. The alignment was chosen in collaboration with the Williams Lake Indian Band and the

current woodlot owner.

DELEGATION OF DECISION-MAKING TO THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER (CEO)

On June 27, 2011 the Commission delegated decision-making to the CEO by Resolution #016N-2011 (File: 140-60/ALC/CEO/APPL). In accordance with section 27 of the *Agricultural Land Commission Act* the Commission has specified that the following applications may be decided by the CEO.

DECISION:

 the proposed power line and road upgrade and construction be in substantial compliance with the plan submitted with the application This decision does not relieve the owner or occupier of the responsibility to comply with applicable Acts, regulations, bylaws of the local government, and decisions and orders of any person or body having jurisdiction over the land under an enactment.
