Minutes of a meeting held by the Provincial Agricultural Land Commission (the "Commission") on June 6, 2014 at the offices of the Commission located at #133 – 4940 Canada Way, Burnaby, BC.

FOR CONSIDERATION

Application: 53657
Applicant: Louis and Patricia Gauthier
Agent: Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations (FLNRO)
Proposal: To include approximately 15.4 ha into the ALR as part of a Crown Grant for the purpose of agricultural – extensive use.
(Submitted pursuant to section 17(3) of the *Agricultural Land Commission Act*)
Legal: Part of NW ¼, DL 1646, Range 5, Coast District
Location: South West of Fort St. James
Background: The application is submitted based on the requirement of Section 8 of the Agricultural Land Administration agreement between the ALC and FLNRO which states that Crown land that is not located within the ALR, and is approved by FLNRO for agricultural purposes, must make application to the ALC for inclusion of land into the ALR. FLNRO completed a site inspection and the land was determined to be arable, consisting of primarily Class 4 soils.

DELEGATION OF DECISION-MAKING TO THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER (CEO)

On June 27, 2011 the Commission delegated decision-making to the CEO by Resolution #016N-2011 (File: 140-60/ALC/CEO/APPL). In accordance with section 27 of the *Agricultural Land Commission Act* the Commission has specified that the following applications may be decided by the CEO.

Criterion 14

Exclusion, subdivision, non-farm use and inclusion applications that are not consistent with any of the existing approved criteria (Criteria 1 - 13) but nonetheless are minor in nature, and in the opinion of the CEO the interests of the Commission would be unaffected by an approval of the application.

DECISION:

After reviewing the entire file material, I, Brian Underhill, Deputy Chief Executive Officer of the Commission, am satisfied that the proposal is consistent with Criterion #14 of Resolution #016N/2011 and approve the application on behalf of the Commission.
