The Village of Telkwa's water distribution system does not have the required water storage capacity to meet its community's needs in regards to fire protection and future development. The Regional

Approval is subject to the following conditions:


 the lease and location of the water reservoir and water main be in substantial compliance with the plan submitted with the application


