The Provincial Agricultural Land Commission (the "Commission") has now concluded its review of your application to place up to 450 cubic metres of fill over a 0.1 ha area of the subject property to level a depressional area. The application was submitted pursuant to section 20(3) of the *Agricultural Land Commission Act* (the "ALCA").

The Commission wishes to thank you for taking the time to meet with its representatives on June 5, 2006 at the property. The Commission found the meeting and site visit informative. In particular, the Commission notes that the intent of your proposal is to construct a level parking/staging area for your agricultural equipment to the south of the existing machine shed. The Commission also noted during the onsite inspection that some fill material has already been placed on the property, in advance of any approvals.

The Commission writes to advise that it has partially approved your application. The Commission will allow an additional 200 cubic metres of fill to be placed on the property subject to:

- the use being restricted to the 0.1 ha area identified on the attached plan;
- compliance with applicable Acts, regulations, bylaws of the local government, and decisions and orders of any person or body having jurisdiction over the land under an enactment. The Commission suggests you contact the District of Saanich at your earliest convenience.

The decision noted above is recorded as Resolution # 287/2006.



# For Consideration

Gordon Bednard presented his staff report dated May 26, 2006 regarding application #C-36662-0.

## Site Inspection

A site inspection was conducted on June 5, 2006. Those in attendance were:

- Commissioners Seitz, Craven & Rugg
- Agricultural Land Commission Staff: Gordon Bednard, Regional Research Officer
- Karl Johnson

The Commission viewed the area proposed for fill placement and discussed the reasons behind the proposal with the applicant.

#### **Commission Discussion**

The Commission considered that the placement of some fill would enhance the use of the property for agriculture by providing parking and firm yard space for agricultural equipment. However, based on observations at the property, the Commission was not convinced that the proponent required the amount of fill requested. There fore the Commission will only allow an additional 200 cubic metres of fill to be placed in a designated area of the property as it feels that this amount is adequate to complete the proposed project.

**PROPOSAL:** To deposit up to 450 cubic metres of fill over a 0.1 ha area of the subject 6.8

ha property to level a depressional area. The property was formerly used as

a deer farm and the present owners intend to develop a tree farm.

This application is made pursuant to section 20(3) of the Agricultural Land

Commission Act.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

No previous ALC applications.

In the application for a fill permit to the District of Saanich, the applicant states the amount of fill required as 150 cubic metres (not the 450 as stated in the ALR application). As well, the applicant states that the project is to provide a parking area in front of an existing outbuilding (no indication of relevance to agricultural development of the property).

# LOCAL GOVERNMENT RECOMMENDATIONS/COMMENTS:

No comment - application not circulated to council

#### STAFF COMMENTS:

Staff would like more detail on the existing uses of the property as it appears there may be structures dedicated to non-farm activity on the property. An onsite inspection and discussion with the applicant may be prudent.

As well, from the photos presented with the application it appears that there may be sufficient material already on the property which could be used to fill the depression. It is the understanding of staff that the applicants began filling the land and were stopped by the local Bylaw Enforcement officer.

Finally, it appears that large rocks have been placed on the property in the proposed fill area which may not be an appropriate type of material for the agricultural enhancement of this area. At this point, without the benefit of an onsite meeting with the applicant, staff recommends the application be held in abeyance until more information on the project is available.
