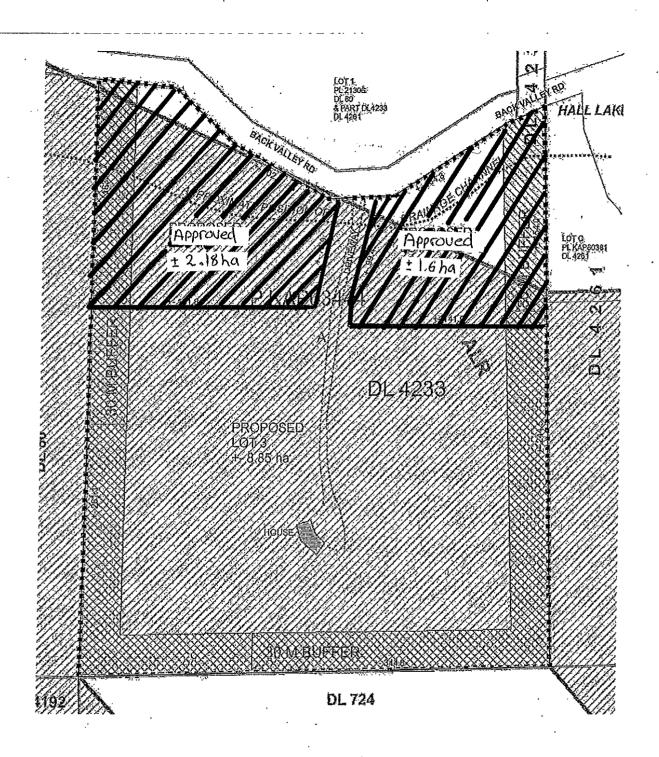

The Commission viewed the property and discussed the plans for subdivision with the agent. The Commission noted that the portion of the property was not in the ALR and that this portion was quite hilly. It also noted that the subject property was topographically separated from the lands to the west that are being used for grazing.

Mr. Hemingway confirmed that the staff report dated August 13, 2007 was received. He pointed out a small mapping error which showed a tiny portion of the road as being part of the subject property.

Context

The proposal was weighed against the purposes of the Commission as stipulated in section 6 of the *Agricultural Land Commission Act* (the "Act"). They are:

- 1. to preserve agricultural land
- 2. to encourage farming on agricultural land in collaboration with other communities of interest, and
- 3. to encourage local governments, first nations, the government and its agents to enable and accommodate farm use of agricultural land and uses compatible with agriculture in their plans, bylaws and policies.

Discussion

Assessment of Agricultural Capability

The Commission believed that the subject property had limited agricultural capability due to topography and its size. The northern part of the property, which was proposed for subdivision, was very hilly and sloped from east to west.

Assessment of Impact on Agriculture

The Commission also assessed the impact of the proposal against the long term goal of preserving agricultural land. The Commission does not believe the proposal would impact existing or potential agricultural use of surrounding lands.

Conclusions

- 1. That the land under application has limited agricultural.
- 2. That the proposal will not impact agriculture.

STAFF COMMENTS:

The applicants are proposing to create two small lots next to the road with the larger remainder located away from the road. A portion of each of the proposed small lots is outside of the ALR. The applicant has proposed inclusion of these areas so they can continue to be used as hobby farms. About half of the proposed 1.6 ha lot is outside of the ALR. A small portion (about 0.1 ha) of the other lot is not in the ALR.
