## Context

The proposal was weighed against the purposes of the Commission as stipulated in section 6 of the *Agricultural Land Commission Act* (the "Act"). They are:

- 1. to preserve agricultural land
- 2. to encourage farming on agricultural land in collaboration with other communities of interest, and
- to encourage local governments, first nations, the government and its agents to enable and accommodate farm use of agricultural land and uses compatible with agriculture in their plans, bylaws and policies.

## Discussion

The Commission noted that the inclusion was to facilitate the sale of the property to enable it to be used for agricultural purposes, in accordance with the agreement between the Integrated Land Management Bureau and the Commission that Crown land sold to a private land owner be included into the ALR as a condition of sale.


