



Exclusion – Newspaper Advertisement

If you are applying to exclude land from the ALR, you are required to provide notice of your application to the public. *(See Sections 15 & 16 of the Agricultural Land Reserve Use, Subdivision and Procedure Regulation.)*

As the applicant, you are responsible for ensuring the notice requirements are fulfilled prior to filing your application with the local government and for all costs arising from providing the notice. The following information outlines the steps to take for advertising the application in a newspaper.

Advertise the application.

- Your application must be advertised on two separate occasions not less than 7 or more than 14 days apart, in a newspaper in general circulation in the municipality or regional district where the property under application is located.
- The wording of the notice must be as specified in the Regulations. *(Refer to the form below.)*
